**Youth B** = Riders 14-18 as of 1/1 of the current year

**Beginner** = riders in their first or second year of showing in any division

**Jr. Novice Horse** = horses 5 and under in their first or second year of showing in any division

**Sr. Novice Horse** = horses 6 and over in their first or second year of showing in any division

**All Day** = walk/trot/halt and back, No Loping.

**Jackpot class** = 50% of take paid to 1st-3<sup>rd</sup> place.
