**CRC YEAR END AWARDS-FREE SIGN UP!** Members interested in having their points counted and calculated for the Year End Awards must sign up at the secretary's stand prior to having points counted. Points will be counted the day we receive your sign up sheet, through the end of the year. There is no fee, we only ask that we have record to be able to follow those interested in the Awards.

**DIVISIONS:** **Youth A** = 13 & under as of January 1 of the current year. **Youth B** = 14-18 as of January 1 of the current year. **Non-pro** = 19 and over as of the current year, amateur rider who does not take money for training or showing horses. **Beginner** = riders who are in their first or second year of showing in any division or discipline. **Lead line** = 9 & under who can safety sit on a horse/pony, may not show in any other division. **Open** = Open to all unless otherwise stated, does not include Lead line. **Junior Novice Horse** = Horses ages 5 and under and in their first or second year of showing in any division or discipline. **Senior Novice Horse** = Horses 6 and over in their first or second year of showing in any division or discipline.

**DIRECTIONS:** Grounds located at: 1800 Franklin Street, Columbia, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania 17512. Take route 30 to the Prospect Road exit. Go south on Prospect Road to Rt. 462.
