A maximum of ten permits will be issued to each novice youth or novice amateur member for the duration of the member's novice eligibility.

Members must pay all entry fees and expenses in connection with showing.

Permits are good for novice division classes only. Points will be awarded and count toward the 25 point cap per skill set for novice eligibility.

Permit must be completed and presented to the show secretary at the time of entry. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

APPLICATION FOR NOVICE PERMIT

Novice amateur and novice youth members may apply for up to ten permits which allow them to compete in one AQHA-approved show per permit with non-owned horses in novice division classes only.

Points earned in these classes will count toward the 25 point cap per skill set for novice eligibility.

Application should be directed to the AQHA Show Department for processing.

Upon receipt of completed application, AQHA will issue the novice member ten permits. Each permit is good for participation at one AQHA-approved show. Permit must be submitted to the show secretary at the time of entry.

Show management must return the permit to AQHA with the results of the show.

TO SHOW MANAGEMENT

Novice permit holders are treated like any other entry in novice classes. Placings and points count. Please be aware of AQHA Rule 413(a): *For AQHA-approved amateur, youth, novice amateur and novice youth classes, AQHA approved shows are required to present ribbons or awards through sixth place.*

However, many AQHA-approved shows offer circuit or all-around awards. *It will be the decision of the management of each show as to whether permit holders will be eligible for the show's all-around novice or circuit awards.*

The novice youth or novice amateur member must present a permit to you at the time of entry. Simply have the exhibitor complete the information on the permit and return it with the results of the show.
